VENUE: - The Upper Gallery in the Harlequin Centre, Watford at the top of the escalator to level 1 of the Palace 'Harlequin' car park.

OPENING TIME: - Friday, 11th July to Sunday 20th July.
Monday – Saturday 10AM to 6PM. Sunday 11 AM to 5PM.

HANDING IN: - Wednesday, 09th July. 9 to 11 AM.

FEES: - £2 per work for the current members of WAAF. **Non members £3 per work.**
We regret no unframed work this time. All cheques payable to **Watford Area Arts Forum**

MEDIA: - Any media may be submitted but **MUST** be original works – **no copies or Giclec prints.**

FRAMING: - All work should be suitable framed apart from 'box canvasses' and **all works to have screw eyes and cord on back of work.**

ENTRY FORM: - An exhibition entry form which is provided with this form must be submitted with the exhibits, please write clearly.

LABELS: - Each work must have a stick on label on the back giving the title, name and price. A label should also be attached so that it will hang over the print or the picture.

INSURANCE: - The insurance of all the exhibits is the responsibility of the individual person. **WAAF can not accept responsibility for loss or damage.**

STEWARDING: - It is a condition of entry that all artists do a stint on stewarding.

COMMISSION: - WAAF will take 20% commission of the sale price of each work.

PRIVATE VIEW: - This will take place on Thursday, 10th July from 6.30 to 8.30PM. All members, exhibitors and their guests are welcome. Please do come, meet the artists and support the exhibition.

COLLECTION: - Artists must collect unsold work on Sunday, 20th July from 3 to 5PM.
