WAAF Competition & Exhibition rules

‘100’

At Watford Museum, 5-28 July 2018

ENTRIES: Subject open to personal interpretation.

The work should measure no more than one metre square.

Each artist can submit up to TWO works of art suitable and prepared for hanging.

All works will be included in the competition.

Hanging may be subject to selection.

Works may be offered for sale on the understanding, they remain part of the exhibition until July 28.

No entry fee and no commission will be charged.

VENUE: The Foyer at Watford Museum, Lower High Street.

OPENING TIMES: Thursday to Saturday, 10am to 5pm. Admission free.

HANDING IN: Wednesday, 4 July , between 11am and 4pm.

MEDIA: Any medium may be submitted, including photography, but must be original works. No copies or Giclee prints.

FRAMING: No formal framing is required but all works should be prepared and ready for hanging.

ENTRY FORMS: An exhibition entry form must be submitted with the exhibits. Please, write clearly.

LABELS: Each work must have a stick-on label on the back giving the title, name and price (if offered for sale). A label should also be attached so that it will hang over the print or the picture.

INSURANCE: The insurance of all the exhibits is the responsibility of the individual person. Watford Museum and WAAF cannot accept responsibility for loss or damage.

PRIZE PRESENTATION RECEPTION: The competition will be judged by local mixed media artist. Sheelagh Frew Crane and announced at 2pm on Saturday, July 28 at the museum, to which all entrants and their guests are invited. (There will be no Private View at the start of the exhibition).

COLLECTION: Artists must collect their work on Saturday, July 28, from 4 to 5pm.
